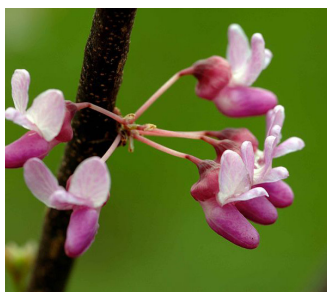


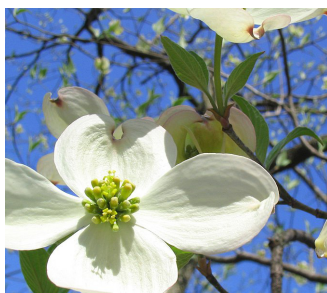
# find the flowering trees

Flowering trees are an important source of nutrient-rich pollen for pollinators. Take a walk through your neighborhood and look for the flowering trees below.



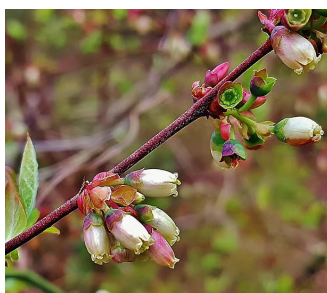
## eastern redbud

Eastern redbud trees display heart-shaped pink blossoms in April. They usually have multiple trunks and are about 20 to 30 feet high.



## flowering dogwood

Dogwood flowers typically have four petals ranging in color from white to pink, and are found on the branches of the trees, near the leaves.



## highbush blueberry

Highbush blueberries are deciduous, perennial shrubs. Their blossoms are white or pink, appearing in clusters at the stem tips.



## serviceberry

Serviceberry bushes bloom in spring with five-petaled, white flowers. The flowers last only a few days and give way to juicy berries that resemble blueberries in size, color and flavor.
