

# SEL experience

Grace Farms' humanitarian mission seeks to create more grace and peace in our local and global communities. The award-winning SANAA-designed River building, with its winding silhouette and glass walls, was designed to be a peaceful respite. As the building meanders down the hillside each glass volume frames a view of the landscape, encouraging visitors to connect with nature while coming together under one continuous roof.

Led by a Grace Farms educator, students will explore the natural landscape and the Garden, play in the Court, pause in the Pavilion, and have a seat at the table in the Commons. This guided tour incorporates participatory, hands-on, inquiry-based activities.

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# the squiggle game

Invite students to take time to draw, collaborate, play, and dream the Squiggle Game!

## Materials

- Washable markers
- Pencils with erasers

## Directions

1. Have each student draw a squiggle on the piece of paper. It can be as messy as they like, as long as it's made without lifting the marker from the page!
2. Collect the sheets of paper and randomly redistribute them, making sure no one gets their own squiggle back.
3. Ask students to turn the squiggle into a picture.
4. After the class is finished, invite students to share their work. What did they find in their squiggles?
